HOMEWORK POLICY

The following times are **guidelines** only so there will be times when your child will have homework that may take more or less time as stated in the guidelines:

Reception to Year 2: 10-20 minutes

Year 3 to Year 7: 20-40 minutes

***This includes reading, sight words or spelling words**

- Please check your child's diary/ homework book each day for homework details.
- Homework is your child's responsibility.
- Talk to your child about their homework, support them.
- Where possible, please ensure your child can do their homework without distractions.
- If for any reason your child cannot complete their homework, please inform the teacher by writing a note in the child's diary/communication book
- If you have any questions about homework, please contact your child's teacher.
