














Preschool

Dear Preschool Families,

The last few weeks have been so fun and exciting for the children at the Preschool. They have enjoyed listening to their favourite story, 'We're going on a bear hunt!' We have incorporated this into our program using our story book table and each time the story has been read (daily, as part of our Pre-Lit program) there is always a child who plays with it and recreates the story. We have been exploring bush tucker and the different ways we can eat and have been colouring in our reconciliation mural which is on



the wall near our group time room. Please encourage your child to come in and contribute to this. With all the wild weather the last few weeks we have also had the opportunity to have lots of discussion around weather, temperatures, seasons etc.

Each group has been lucky enough to have a visit from the Elizabeth MFS. We have learnt about good fires and bad fires, what to do if there is smoke in the home and where to go to evacuate if there is fire. The children have also had the opportunity to be a firefighter and put out a 'pretend' fire (orange cones) with the hose, and get in the fire truck and have a seat in there.
